1

Paul's prayer requests for them:

- that they would "be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding" (James 1:5)
- that they would "walk in a manner worthy of the Lord"

"walk" = conduct in life

"Worthy walk":

- pleasing Him in all respects: upward
- bearing fruit in every good work: outward
- increasing in the knowledge of God: inward
- strengthened by Him: empowered
- steadfastness, patience, joy: attitude in service
- giving thanks to the Father: recognizing what He has done for us!

I Peter 1:3-4: "...our Lord Jesus Christ,
Who...has caused us to be born again to a
living hope...to obtain **an inheritance** which
is imperishable and undefiled and will not
fade away, **reserved in heaven for you.**"

II Tim 2:25b-26 "...God may grant them
repentance leading to the knowledge of the
truth, and they may come to their senses and
escape from the snare of **the devil, having
been held captive by him** to do his will."

Col 1: 15: "image of the invisible God"
EIKON = image or likeness; an exact
representation and revelation
"Image of God" denotes the eternal Son's
perfect equality with the Father in respect
of His substance, nature, and eternity.

"In His essence, **God is invisible, but Jesus
Christ has revealed Him** to us." W Wiersbe

"...Jesus Christ is the perfect, absolutely
accurate image of God. **He did not become
the image of God at the incarnation, but has
been that from all eternity.**" J MacArthur

“The incarnation did not create visible-ness: it only displayed it....It is the Son’s uncreated, inherent, self-subsisting nature to be what He is—
the visible representation of God.”

“firstborn of creation”

PROTOTOKOS = refers primarily to preeminence in position or rank; meaning of first importance, of first rank

The relation of Christ to God the Father:
“the image of the invisible God”

The relation of Christ to creation:
“the firstborn of creation”

The relation of Christ to His church:
“the head of the body, the church.”

Col 1:23 “if indeed you continue...”

“If, as the case is, you continue in the faith...”

“Seeing that you continue...”

“Since you continue...”

“Inasmuch as you continue...”

→all indicate an assurance of the fact

Lessons from Colossians 1:

1. Need for encouragement and prayer for fellow believers.
Col 1:1-3, ff
2. Pray, not only for physical needs, but for spiritual growth.
Col 1:9-11
3. As believers, we represent the Lord and ought to walk in a manner worthy of Him. Col 1:10
4. The position we have in Christ: part of His kingdom, share in His inheritance, redeemed, forgiven, reconciled, holy, and blameless! Col 1:12-13, 20-22
5. The preeminence of Christ over all else! Col 1:15-23
