

Paul under house arrest:

"And he stayed two full years in his own rented quarters and was **welcoming all who came to him**, preaching the kingdom of God **and teaching concerning the Lord Jesus Christ....**"

Paul's purpose in Colossians:

1. To encourage them in their faith.
2. To teach them sound doctrine.
3. To correct false teaching.

Elements of the false teaching:

1. A Jewish element = legalism.
2. A Pagan element = early Gnosticism, mysticism.
3. A Christian element; didn't deny Christ but dethroned Him.
