

Sin: general term for any wrongdoing



Transgression, trespasses: choosing to disobey, rejecting God's authority.



Iniquity: premeditated, ongoing

The conviction of sin Psalm 32:3-4

...my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long. For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer.

Confession and Forgiveness Psalm 32:5

I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not cover my iniquity; I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD," and you forgave the iniquity of my sin.



Sin is rebellion against God.
Confession and repentance are surrender to God.

Restoration and Praise (Psalm 32:6-7)

Therefore let everyone who is godly offer prayer to you at a time when you may be found; surely in the rush of great waters, they shall not reach him. You are a hiding place for me; you preserve me from trouble; you surround me with shouts of deliverance.

Guidance Psalm 32:8

I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my eye upon you.

Emphasis in Hebrew Poetry

Contrast v 10

Many are the sorrows of the wicked,
But he who trusts in the LORD,
lovingkindness shall surround him.

Parallelism v11

Be glad in the LORD and rejoice, you righteous ones; And shout for joy, all you who are upright in heart

Trust in the just and merciful character of God vv 18, 17

...whenever our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and he knows everything. (1 John 3:20 ESV)

There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. ... Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died...who is at the right hand of God, ...interceding for us. (Romans 8:1, 33-34 ESV)

For as the heavens are high above the earth, So great is Your mercy toward me; As far as the east is from the west, So far have You removed my transgressions from me. As a father pities his children, So You pity me, For You know my frame; You remember that I am dust.

Psalm 103:8-14 (as a Prayer)

O Lord, You are merciful and gracious, Slow to anger, and abounding in mercy. You will not always strive with me, Nor will You keep Your anger forever. You have not dealt with me according to my sins, Nor punished me according to my iniquities.

PSALM 42

As the deer pants for the water brooks, so my soul pants for Thee, O God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God; When shall I come and appear before God? My tears have been my food day and night, while they say to me all day long, "Where is your God?"

16

These things I remember, and I pour out my soul within me.

For I used to go along with the throng and lead them in procession to the house of God, with the voice of joy and thanksgiving, a multitude keeping festival

Why are you in despair, O my soul? And why have you become disturbed within me?

Hope in God, for I shall again praise Him for the help of His presence
