

Memory Passage: Psalm 42:

Ps 42:1-3
As the deer pants for the water brooks, so my soul pants for You, O God.
My soul thirsts for God, for the living God; when shall I come and appear before God?
My tears have been my food day and night, while they say to me all day long, "Where is your God?"

Memory Passage: Psalm 42:

Ps 42:4-6
These things I remember and I pour out my soul within me. For I used to go along with the throng and lead them in procession to the house of God, with the voice of joy and thanksgiving, a multitude keeping festival.
Why are you in despair, O my soul? And why have you become disturbed within me? Hope in God, for I shall again praise Him for the help of His presence.
O my God, my soul is in despair within me; therefore I remember You from the land of the Jordan and the peaks of Hermon, from Mount Mizar.

- **Gen 1:3**—“Then God said, ‘**Let there be light**’ and there was light.”
- **I John 1:5** “...**God is Light**, and in Him there is no darkness at all.”
- **I Tim 6:15-16** “...the King of kings and Lord of lords, who alone possesses immortality and **dwells in unapproachable light**, whom no man has seen or can see....”
- **John 8:12** “Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, ‘**I am the Light of the world**; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life.’”

- **Is 40:22** “It is He who sits above **the circle of the earth**, and its inhabitants are like grasshoppers, Who **stretches out the heavens like a curtain** and **spreads them out like a tent to dwell in.**”
- **Is 44:24** “Thus says the LORD, your Redeemer...I, the LORD, am the maker of all things, **stretching out the heavens by Myself** and spreading out the earth all alone.”
- **Amos 9:6** “The One who **builds His upper chambers in the heavens** and has founded **His vaulted dome** over the earth, He who **calls for the waters of the sea and pours them out on the face of the earth**, The LORD is His name.”

104:4 *"makes the winds His messengers, flaming fire His ministers"* (NAS)

KJV: "who maketh his *angels spirits*, his ministers a flaming fire."

- **MALAK** = angel, messenger, ambassador; root: to dispatch as a deputy
- **RUWACH** = wind, spirit; root: breath

Psalm 148:7-8 "Praise the LORD from the earth, sea monsters and all deeps; *fire* and hail, snow and clouds; *stormy wind, fulfilling His word...*"

Heb 1:7 "And *of the angels He says*, 'Who makes His angels winds, and His ministers a flame of fire.'"

104:9a *"You set a boundary* that they may not pass over"

Job 38:8-11 The Lord talking to Job: "...who enclosed the sea with doors...and I *placed boundaries* on it and set a bolt and doors, and I said, 'Thus far you shall come, but no father; and *here shall your proud waves stop?*'"

Jer 5:22 "...For I have *placed the sand as a boundary for the sea*, an eternal decree, so it cannot cross over it. Though the waves toss, yet they roar, yet they cannot cross over it."

His hand the wonders wrought.

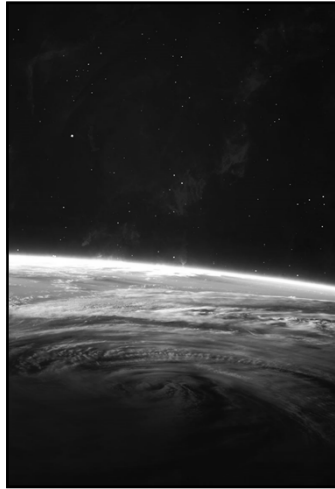
