## Memory Passage: Psalm 42:


**Ps 42:7-9**







### Three interpretations of Psalm 24:

- 1. Historically:** occasion of the return of the ark of the covenant to Jerusalem. II Samuel 6
- 2. Typically:** The ascension of the Lord Jesus back to the Father’s right hand following the resurrection.
- 3. Prophetically:** The Lord’s coming in glory to establish His kingdom on the earth.

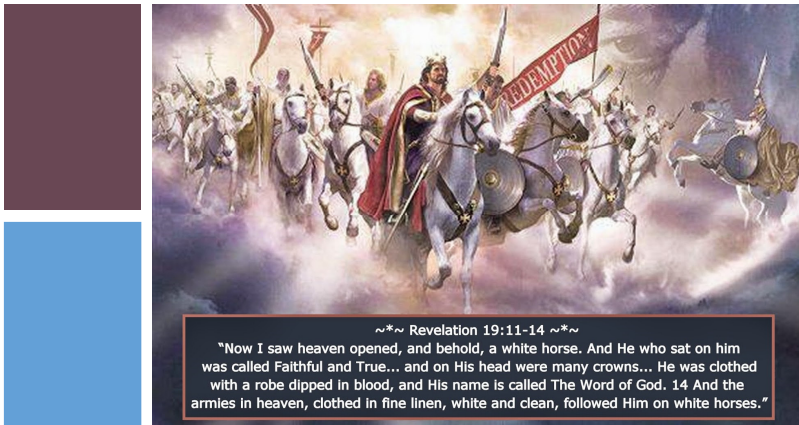

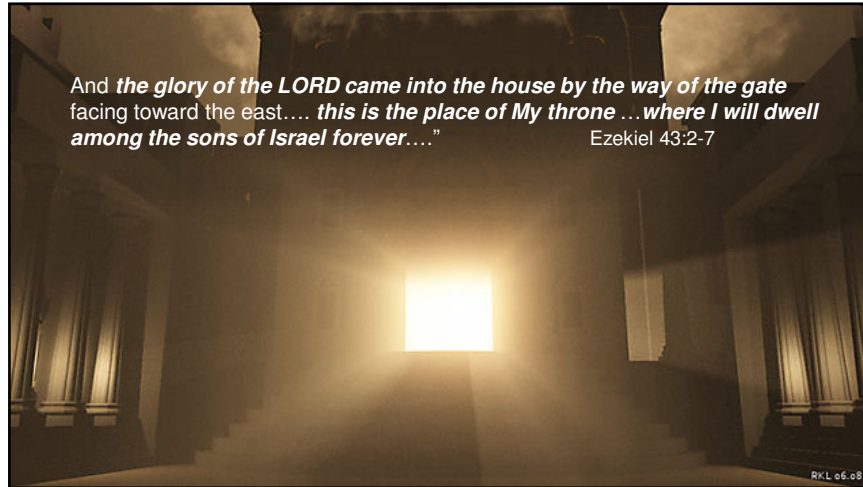
