Inpiration = a special act of the Holy Spirit, whereby He guided the writers of the books of the Bible, so that ***their words should convey the thoughts and words that He wished to convey,*** should bear a proper relationship to the other inspired books of the Bible, ***and that all the words should be kept free from errors of fact, doctrine, and judgment.***

Seven attributes of the Son: vs. 2-3 (Col 1:1-20)

1. He is appointed Heir of all things.
2. He made the world. (John 1:3)
3. He is the radiance (effulgence) of God’s glory.
4. He is the exact representation of God’s nature.
5. He upholds all things. (Col 1:17)
6. He made purification of sins. (Heb 10:4)
7. He is seated at the right hand of God.
