No one can serve two masters. Either he will hate one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money.



Don't Be Greedy

- 1:19 So are the ways of everyone who is greedy for gain. It takes away the life of its owners.
- 15:27 He who is greedy for gain troubles his own house, but he who hates bribes will live.

- 3:27 Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due, when it is in your power to do it.

How cheerful is the USA? (Per Giving USA)

- Average annual charity donation in 2020 was \$737 (High net worth gave an average \$29, 269, rest average \$2,514.)
- Jewish people average \$2,526, Protestants \$1,749, Muslims \$1,178 and Catholics \$1,142.
- Average American gives \$17/week to their local church (\$884/yr)
- 37% of weekly “faithful” don’t give anything at all

How indebted is the USA? (2021 CNBC)

- Average American has \$90,460 in debt (credit cards, personal loans, mortgages, student debt)
- Gen Z (ages 18 to 23): \$16,043
- Millennials (ages 24 to 39): \$87,448
- Gen X (ages 40-55): \$140,643
- Baby Boomers (ages 56-74): \$97,290
- Silent Generation (ages 75 and above): \$41,281
