Romans 9:4-5 Israel's privileges:

- The adoption as sons
- The glory = the manifestation of God's presence
 - Exodus 40:34-35 "Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and *the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle*. Moses was not able to enter the tent of meeting because the cloud had settled on it, and *the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.*" also Ex 13:20-21;16:10

- The giving of the Law: shows the need for a Savior
- The temple service: shows the need for payment for their sins and a foreshadow of Christ

Romans 9:5

“from whom [*tribe of Judah*] is the Christ”
 “according to the flesh” = His humanity
 “Who is over all, God” = His deity

John 8:37 “I know that you are **Abraham's descendants**; yet you seek to kill Me because My word has no place in you.”

John 8:39 “They [the Pharisees] answered and said to Him, ‘Abraham is our father.’ Jesus said to them, ‘**If you are Abraham's children, do the deeds of Abraham.**’”

Jn 8:44 “You are **of your father the devil...**”

Gen 29:30-31 Jacob “**loved** [ahab] Rachel more than Leah....Now the Lord saw that Leah was **unloved** [sane = hated].”

Luke 14:26 “If anyone...does not **hate** his own father and mother and wife and children...he cannot be My disciple.”

Eph 5:25 “Husbands, **love** your wives....”

Illustrations of God's sovereign choice:

Illustrations of God's sovereign choice:

- Pharoah: “I raised you up, *to demonstrate My power...that My name might be proclaimed....*” Rom 9:17-18
- “...He hardens whom He desires.” v.18
 - Pharoah hardened his heart: 7-8 times
 - The LORD hardened Pharoah's heart: 7-8 times

Is 45:9 “Woe to the one who quarrels with his Maker—an earthenware vessel among the vessels of the earth! **Will the clay say to the potter, ‘What are you doing?’....**”

Job 40:2 “...**Will you condemn Me that you may be justified?**”

Romans 9:22

“What if God, although willing to demonstrate His wrath and make His power known, endured with much patience **vessels of wrath prepared for destruction?**”

Romans 9:22

“What if **God**, although willing to demonstrate His wrath and make His power known, **endured with much patience** vessels of wrath prepared for destruction?”

“And He did so **to make known the riches of His glory upon vessels of mercy**, which He prepared beforehand for glory.” Romans 9:23

Romans 9:22 “*prepared* for destruction”

Romans 9:23 “*prepared*...for glory.”

v.22 “*prepared*” = fitted, ripe, ready

v.23 “*prepared*” = ordained, Eph 2:10

v.22 “*prepared*” = passive or middle voice = “fitted themselves for destruction”

v.23 “*prepared*” = active, aorist = God prepared or ordained these vessels for glory.

Ephesians 2:3-5

“...we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh...and **were by nature children of wrath....But God, being rich in mercy**, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, **made us alive together with Christ....**”

Romans 9:33 “Stone of stumbling and a Rock of offense” – quotes Isaiah 8:13-14; 28:16

I Pet 2:4-8 “And coming to Him as to a *living stone* which has been rejected by men, but is choice and precious in the sight of God....For this is contained in Scripture: ‘Behold, I lay in Zion a *choice stone*, a *precious cornerstone*, and he who believes in Him will not be disappointed.’ This precious value, then is for you who believe; but for those who disbelieve, ‘The stone which the builders rejected became the very corner stone’ and, ‘a stone of stumbling and a rock of offense’; for they stumble because they are disobedient to the word, and to this doom they were also appointed.”
