Human Responsibility

- **They didn't pursue God's righteousness by faith (9:31-32)**
- **They stumbled over the stumbling block. (9:32-33)**

How Does Man Respond?

- God's righteousness comes from the heart (vv 1-13)
- God's righteousness comes from hearing (vv 14-21)
- *For Christ is the end of the law of righteousness to everyone who believes.*
Romans 10:4

From the Heart

- 10:1 *Brethren, my heart's desire and my prayer to God for them is for their salvation.*
- 10:2 Zeal isn't the same as heart knowledge
- 10:3 "Seeking to establish their own" means "going about with strenuous effort and toilsome labor" to be righteous, not from the heart

Law Pointed to Christ

- Animal sacrifices were necessary for fellowship with God and as a payment for sin
- Temple sacrifices showed that *"blood...to make atonement for your souls."* (Leviticus 17:11)
- *"...Jesus was the Lamb of God to take away the sins of the world."* (John 1:29) He died in the manner described in Isaiah 53.

Deuteronomy 30:12-14

- ***“It is not in heaven, that you should say, ‘Who will go up to heaven to get it for us and make us hear it, that we may observe it?’***
- ***Nor is it beyond the sea, that you should say, ‘Who will cross the sea for us to get it for us and make us hear it, so that we may observe it?’***

Romans 10:6-8

- ***“But the righteousness based on faith speaks thus, ‘Do not say in your heart, ‘Who will ascend into heaven?’ (that is to bring Christ down),***
- ***Or ‘Who will descend into the abyss?’ (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead).***

Deuteronomy 30:14

- ***But the word is very near you, in your mouth and in your heart, that you may observe it.***

Romans 10:8-10

- ***But what does it say? ‘The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart’—that is, the word of faith which we are preaching,***
- ***that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved;***
- ***for with the heart man believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.***

Process for someone to be able to call upon the name of the Lord.

1. Preachers must be sent.

- Vs 15 *How will they preach unless they are sent?*
- God sent the prophets, John the Baptist’s teachings, Jesus’ teachings, miracles, death, resurrection, Pentecost, preaching of Paul and the apostles, other preachers.

Process for someone to be able to call upon the name of the Lord.

2. Preachers must preach.

- Vs 14c *And how will they hear without a preacher?*
- Vs. 15/Isaiah 52:7 *“How beautiful are the feet of those who bring glad tidings of good things!”*

Process for someone to be able to call upon the name of the Lord.

3. People must hear preaching.

- Vs 14b *How will they believe in Him whom they have not heard?*
- Vs. 18/Psalm 19:4 *“Their voice has gone out into all the earth, and their words to the ends of the world.”*

Process for someone to be able to call upon the name of the Lord.

4. People must believe in Christ as Lord.

- *Vs 14a How then will they call on Him in whom they have not believed?*
- *Vs. 16/Isaiah 53:1 "Lord, who has believed our report?"*
- Israelites chose not to believe.
