Note what John says about “the Word”:

- He was “in the beginning” = eternity past
- He was “with God” = a distinct person from God the Father
- He “was God” = the Word is deity = God!
- v.14 “the Word became flesh and dwelt among us” = Jesus!

**“Word” = LOGOS** = message; something said or communicated

- **To the Greeks:** LOGOS = the organizing principle of the world that gives shape and meaning to things.

Ex: **theology**, **psychology**, **biology**, **zoology**

- **To the Jewish minds:** “the Word of the LORD” - used 242 times in the Old Testament; how God spoke to and communicated with His people; Hosea 1:1 “the word of the LORD came to Hosea”

“It should be clear that when John wrote of “the Word”, he was using a term which... Jew and Gentile, would grasp.... just as words are the expression of thoughts, so to call Christ the Word was to regard Him as the communication of the Divine Wisdom, the personal revelation of the truth of God.... not just the communicator, but the communication itself. He did not merely tell God’s truth. He was the truth. (John 14:6).” Homer Kent
