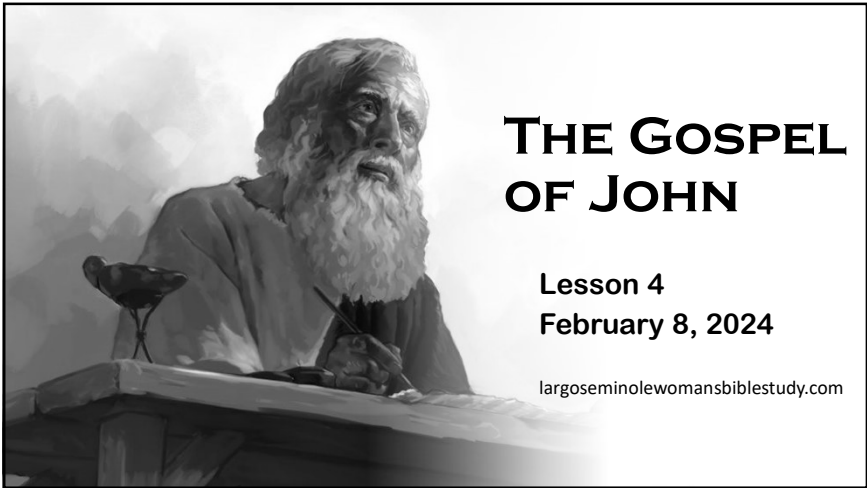

- John 2:4 “My hour has not yet come.”
- John 7:30; 8:20 “His hour had not yet come.”
- John 12:23; 13:1; 17:1 “the hour HAS come” or “His hour HAD come.”

Fulfillment of Prophecy:

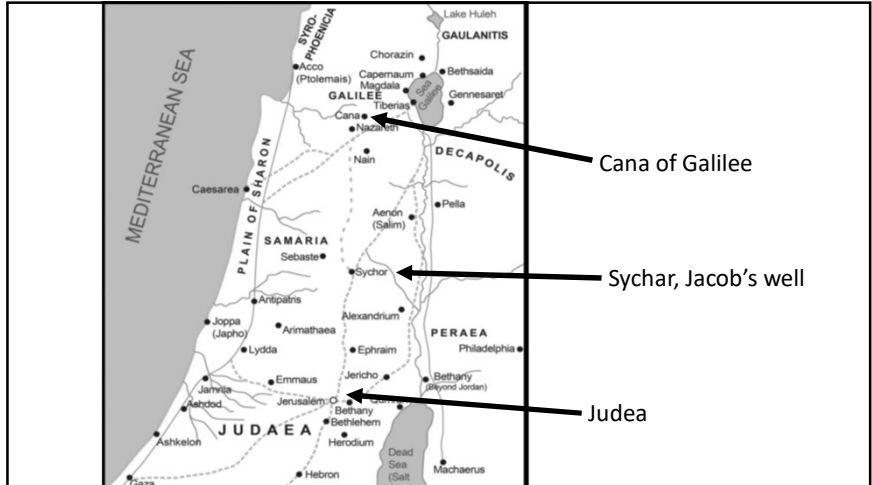
- Isaiah 9:1-2 “... He shall make it glorious, by the way of the sea, on the other side of the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles. The people who walk in darkness will see a great light; those who live in a dark land, the light will shine on them.”
- Isaiah 9:6 “For a child will be born to us, a Son will be given to us...Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.”

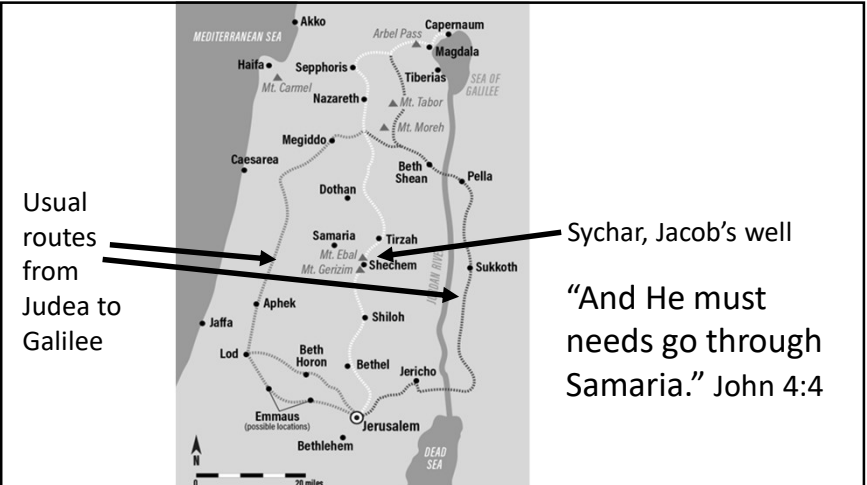

**II Kings 17:24-41** “*The king of Assyria brought men* from Babylon and from Cuthah and from Avva and from Hamath and Sepharvaim, and settled them in the cities of Samaria in place of the sons of Israel.... But **every nation still made gods of its own** and put them in the houses of the high places which the people of Samaria had made....They also feared the LORD and **appointed from among themselves priests** of the high places....**and served their own gods** according to the custom of the nations....**So while these nations feared the LORD, they also served their gods**; their children likewise and their grandchildren, as their fathers did, **so they do to this day.**”

**Ezra 4:1-5** “Now when **the enemies of Judah and Benjamin** heard that the people of the exile were building a temple to the LORD God of Israel, they approached Zerubbabel....and said to them, ‘Let us build with you, for we, like you, seek your God; and **we have been sacrificing to Him since the days of Esarhaddon King of Assyria, who brought us up here.** But Zerubbabel...said to them, ‘**You have nothing in common with us** in building a house to our God....Then **the people of the land discouraged** the people of Judah, and **frightened them** from building, and **hired counselors again them to frustrate** their counsel....”

**Nehemiah 4:1-9** Sanballat (with the Samaritans) brings opposition to the rebuilding of the wall around Jerusalem.

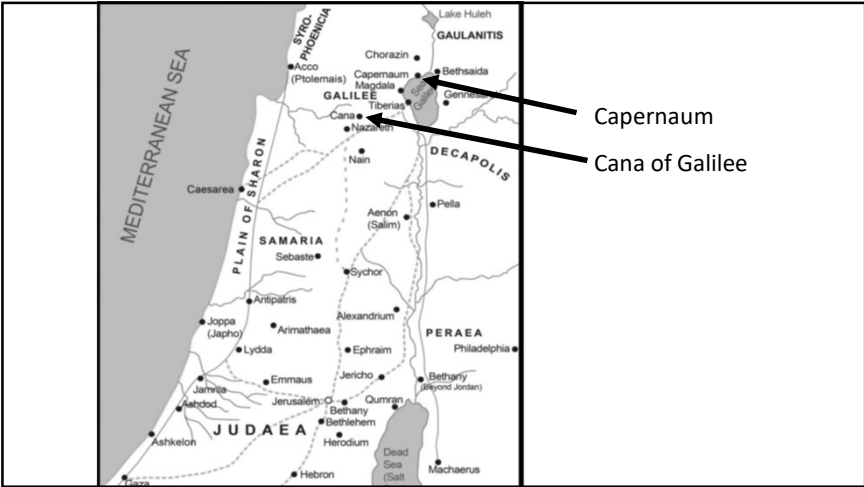

- “I who speak to you am *He*.”  
lit.= “I AM, the one speaking to you”
- Exodus 3:14 “God said to Moses, “I AM WHO I AM.” And He said, “Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel: ‘I AM has sent me to you’”
- The Old Testament “I AM” = Jesus!

Lessons from John 4:

1. Demonstration of Jesus’ omniscience: He knew all about the woman. Jn 4:29

2. Demonstration of Jesus’ omnipotence: He can heal, whether physically present or at a distance. Jn 4:50-52

3. Jesus fulfills the prophecies of the Messiah. Jn 4:25-26

4. Salvation is available to all people. He is the “Savior of the world.” Jn 4:42

5. Jesus has a mission for His followers to do. The “fields” are ready for “harvest.” Jn 4:35
