







•John 17:12 “While I was with them, I was keeping them...I guarded them and not one of them perished but the son of perdition, so that the Scripture would be fulfilled.”

“the cup” = suffering and judgment for sin:

- Ps 75:8 “For a cup is in the hand of the LORD...Surely all the wicked of the earth must drain and drink....”
- Is 51:17-22 “You have drunk from the LORD’s hand the cup of His anger....”
- Jer 25:15 “Take this cup of the wine of wrath from My hand...”
- Ezek 23:31-34 “the cup of horror and desolation....”

“the cup” = suffering and judgment for sin:

- Rev 14:10 “...he will drink of the wine of the wrath of God...in the cup of His anger....”
- Rev 16:19 “...to give her the cup of the wine of His fierce wrath.”
- II Cor 5:21 “He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.”

Jesus alludes to Messianic prophecies:
Daniel 7:13-14 and Psalm 110:1

- Mt 26:64 “...you shall see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven.”
- Lk 22:69-70 “But from now on the Son of Man will be seated at the right hand of the power of God.’ And they all said, ‘Are You the Son of God, then?’ And He said to them, ‘Yes, I am.’”
