5th Trial — Herod Antipas; Luke 23:8-12

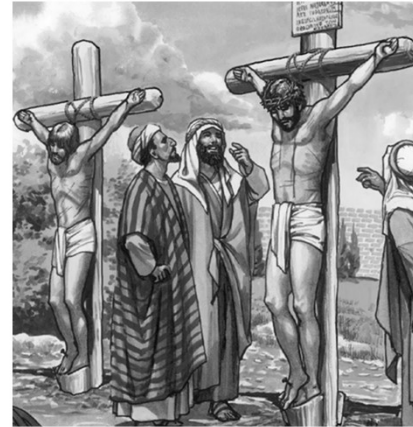
6th Trial — Pilate for the second time; Luke 23:13-25

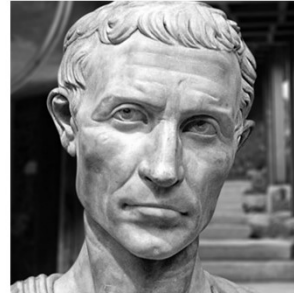

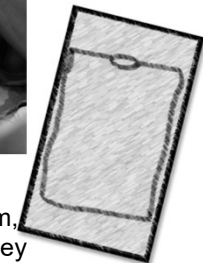
