






With Pilate's permission, he came and took the body away. He was accompanied by Nicodemus, the man who earlier had visited Jesus at night.

but secretly because he feared the Jews.






“Now on the first day of the week Mary Magdalene came early to the tomb, while it was still dark, and saw the stone already taken away from the tomb.”







John 20:23 “If you forgive the sins...”

Acts 10:40-43 “God raised Him up on the third day and granted that **He become visible**, not to all the people, but **to witnesses who were chosen** beforehand...to us who ate and drank with Him after He arose from the dead. And **He ordered us to preach** to the people....that through His name **everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins.**”

Some proofs of His bodily resurrection:

- Stone rolled away
- Empty tomb
- Linen wrappings & face cloth
- Two angels appeared and told them
- Appearance to Mary & to His disciples
- Could be touched; His voice could be heard
- His wounds were still visible
- He ate food in their presence (Lk 24:41-43)

“Jesus manifested Himself to His disciples at the Sea of Tiberius” John 21:1

• Jesus had told them at the last supper, “But after I have been raised, **I will go ahead of you to Galilee.**”

Matthew 26:32

• The angels told the women “go, tell His disciples **and Peter, He is going ahead of you to Galilee;** there you will see Him, **just as He told you.**”

Two different words for “love” were used:

AGAPAO = a sacrificial love; desiring the best for the one loved
PHILEO = fond affection for; “brotherly love”

21:15 Jesus: “Simon...do you love [AGAPAO] Me more than these?”

Simon: “Yes, Lord; You know that I love [PHILEO] You.”

21:16 Jesus: “Simon...do you love [AGAPAO] Me?”

Simon: “Yes, Lord; You know that I love [PHILEO] You.”

21:17 Jesus: “Simon... do you love [PHILEO] Me?”

Simon: “Lord, You know all things; You know that I love [PHILEO] You.”

“Since you have in obedience to the truth purified your souls for a **sincere love of the brethren** [PHILADELPHIA], **fervently love** [AGAPAO] one another from the heart.” I Peter 1:22

“**Shepherd the flock of God** among you, exercising oversight not under compulsion, but voluntarily...not for sordid gain, but with eagerness, nor yet as lording it over those allotted to your charge, but **proving to be examples to the flock**. And *when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory.*” I Peter 5:2-4

Peter looks at John and asks:
“**What about him?**” Jn 21:20-21
Jesus’ answer: “**What is that to you? You follow Me!**” Jn 21:22

“I, John, your brother and **fellow partaker in the tribulation** and kingdom and perseverance which are in Jesus, was on **the island called Patmos because of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus.**” Revelation 1:9

Two important lessons:

•**Chapter 20: The resurrection is true!**

Rom 10:9 "If you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved."

There is no salvation, no forgiveness without the resurrection:

I Cor 15:13,17 "If there is no resurrection of the dead, not even Christ has been raised; and if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is vain, and your faith also is vain....and if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins."

Two important lessons:

•**Chapter 20: The resurrection is true!**

•**Chapter 21: Restoration is important!**

Christ offers forgiveness and restoration.

"...Tend My lambs....Shepherd My sheep....Tend My sheep....You follow Me!" John 21:15-17,22

And the Lord has a job for you to do, too!
