### Zechariah:

- His name means "The Lord remembers"
- His ministry: 50 years, 520-470 BC
- Only one author = Zechariah
  - Dead Sea Scrolls: one scroll
  - Ch 1-8 written earlier
  - Ch 9-14 written later in his ministry

### Zechariah:



- One of 12 books that is referred to as a "minor prophet."
- The longest of the minor prophets; second only to Isaiah in Messianic prophecies, prophecies about Jesus.
- Called the "apocalypse of the OT"
- Quoted 71 times in the NT:
  - 1/3 of those are in the gospels
  - 31 times in Revelation

## God's sovereignty:

➤ “God is the sovereign Lord of history, and nothing happens, either to Israel or to the gentile nations, that is not the result of His direct determination.”

## God's Holiness:

“An awareness of holiness was the driving force behind their sharp denunciation of sin. It made no difference where the sin was found, whether in foreign lands...or among God's people — it was still an offense to God and called for judgment.”



"God's love....is not incompatible with justice. On the contrary, it is because of God's great love for his people...that He sends prophets with the message of judgment ....He judges sin...to turn them back from sin to Himself...."
