### 1. Is there an example for me to follow?

Ephesians 5:25 “Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her.”



### 2. Is there a sin for me to avoid?

Eph.6:4a “And, fathers, do not provoke your children to anger.”

6:6 “not by way of eyeservice, as men-pleasers.”

6:9 “And, masters, give up threatening.”



### 3. Is there a command for me to obey?

Eph.5:22 & 33 “Wives, be subject to your own husbands.”  
“And let the wife see to it that she respect her husband.”

5:25 & 29 “Husbands, love your wives.” (nourish & cherish)

6:1 “Children, obey your parents.”

6:5 “Slaves, be obedient to those who are your masters.”



4. Is there a promise for me to claim

Eph.5:23 "Savior of the body."

5:25 "Christ also loved the church."

5:26 "Cleansed her by the washing of water with the word."

5:27 "No spot or wrinkle, holy and blameless."

5:29 "Nourishes and cherishes, just as Christ does."

6:3 "That it might be well with you and that you live long."

6:8 "Whatever good thing each one does, this he will receive back from the Lord."



5. What does this passage teach me about the Trinity: **God** the Father, **Christ** the Son, **Holy Spirit**

Eph.6:6 "Doing the will of **God** from the heart."

6:9 "**Master** is in heaven and there is no partiality with Him."

5:23 "**Christ** is the Head of the church, the Savior of the body"

6:8 "He will receive back from the **Lord**." (Rewards)

No mention of the **Holy Spirit** in this passage.



6. Is there a difficulty or mystery for me to explore?

Eph.5:32 "This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church."

5:22 "Wives be subject to your husbands."



7. Is there something in this passage to pray about?

Pray Scripture. Put your name or someone's in it. Pray for all your relationships: God, marriage, family, friendships, church, and work.
